Scottie Dog No. 9633

MATERIALS:

Columbia Germantown, 1 ounce balls. 7 balls Black, 50. Utopia Knitting Worsted, 4 ounce skeins. 4 skeins Black (for stuffing).

NEEDLES:

Athena Nonflammable Needles, size 5—14 inch. Athena Nonflammable Crochet Hook, size 4.

GAUGE:

6 sts = 1 inch. 12 rows = 1 inch.

The entire dog is worked in garter st with crocheted loops worked after the knitting is completed.

CROCHETED LOOP PATTERN:

Attach yarn, * insert hook and pull a loop through next st, y o hook, draw through loop on hook to desired length (about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch on body, and 1 inch on chin, eye brows, and under portion of body to hind legs), repeat from * across row. Hold a number of loops on needle to keep even length and work a row of loops st on every row of garter st.

Enlarge charts to actual size and work pieces by following chart. Multiply the number of sts to the inch by the number of inches required and k to fit. After pieces have been made, work loop st over entire animal. Clip each loop to resemble fur.

TO ASSEMBLE:

Sew together. Stuff animal with 4 inch strands of yarn. Attach ears, and sew buttons in place for eyes. Tie a scotch plaid ribbon bow around neck.
