Chair Set page 12

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S BIG BALL MERCERIZED CROCHET, *Size 30* (about 20 yards are required for 1 pull).
Steel Crochet Hook No. 10 or 11.
1 bone ring, 1/2 inch in diameter.

1st rnd: Make 40 sc in bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in next 2 sc, * ch 3, skip 1 sc, dc in next 3 sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, sl st in top st of starting chain. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, * dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch-4. Join as before. **4th rnd:** Sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 4, 3 dc in next sp, ch 4, skip 1 dc, dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. **5th rnd:** Sl st in next dc, ch 7, * skip next sp, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, ch 4. Repeat from * around. Join last ch-4 with sl st to 3rd st of starting chain. **6th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 2, 2 dc in next dc; (p, dc in next dc) 4 times—to make a p, ch 3 and sc in 3rd ch from hook—dc in same place as last dc, ch 2, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, sl st in 1st sc made. Fasten off.

Chair Set page 9

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS or CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, *Size 20* (about 15 yards are required for 1 pull).
Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 or 9.
1 bone ring, 1/2 inch in diameter.
1/3 yard narrow velvet ribbon.

1st rnd: Make 36 sc in bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc. **2nd rnd:** Ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, tr in next 3 sc, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster is made); * ch 4, make a 2-tr cluster over next 2 sc, ch 4, make a 4-tr cluster over next 4 sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch-4, sl st in tip of 1st cluster. **3rd rnd:** * 4 sc in next sp, sc in tip of next cluster. Repeat from * around. Join. **4th rnd:** Ch 3, in same place as sl st make dc, ch 3 and 2 dc, * ch 3, 2 dc in sc at tip of next cluster, ch 3, in sc at tip of next cluster make 2 dc, ch 3 and 2 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, sl st in 3rd st of ch-3 first made. **5th rnd:** Ch 3, dc in each dc and 3 dc in each sp. Join. **6th rnd:** Ch 1, sc in each dc, making 3 sc at each point. Join and fasten off.

CORD ... Same as for No. 7670A on this page. Pass ribbon through spaces and make a bow.

Chair Set page 6

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS or CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, *Size 30* (about 20 yards are required for 1 pull).
Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 or 9.
1 bone ring about 3/4 inch in diameter.

1st rnd: Sc closely over bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc. Now work in rows (back and forth). **1st row:** Ch 5, in same place as sl st make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell is made); ch 3, skip 6 sc, in next sc make 2 dc, ch 5 and 2 dc; ch 3, skip 6 sc, in next sc make a shell as before. Ch 5, turn. **2nd row:** Shell in sp of shell (shell over shell is made), ch 3, in ch-5 sp make 15 tr, ch 3, shell over shell. Hereafter "shell over shell" will be referred to as "s.o.s." Ch 5, turn. **3rd row:** S.o.s., ch 3, tr in each tr with ch-1 between, ch 3, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn. **4th row:** S.o.s., ch 3, sc in first ch-1 sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) 13 times, ch 3, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn. **5th row:** S.o.s., ch 3, skip next ch-3, sc in next loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 12 times, ch 3, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn. **6th row:** S.o.s., ch 3, skip next ch-3, sc in next loop, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 11 times, ch 3, s.o.s. Ch 5, turn.

Continue in this manner, having 1 loop less on each row until 1 loop remains. Ch 5, turn. **Last row:** S.o.s., ch 3, sc in loop, ch 3, 2 dc in sp of next shell, ch 1, sc in sp of last complete shell made, ch 1, 2 dc in same shell where last 2 dc were made, ch 5, turn, sc in joining sc (between last 2 shells). Fasten off.

CORD ... Cut 6 strands of thread, each 1 yard long. Twist these strands tightly. Now double these strands and give them a second twist in the opposite direction. Knot free ends. Sew to pull as in illustration.
