MATERIALS:

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY POM-
PADOUR, 1 ball ($\frac{3}{4}$ oz. ball).

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Sock Needles,
1 set No. 1 and 1 set No. 4.

GAUGE: (STOCKINETTE STITCH) 7 sts
make 1 inch; 10 rnds make 1 inch.

Starting at wrist, cast on 32 sts onto
three No. 4 needles. Join, being careful
not to twist sts. **1st rnd:** With No. 1
needles, * k 2, p 2. Repeat from *
around. Repeat 1st rnd until piece meas-
ures $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Change to No. 4 needles.

HAND . . . Work around in stockinette
st (k each rnd) for $\frac{3}{4}$ inch. **Next rnd:**
Drop yarn; with contrasting color thread
for thumb marker, work across first 5 sts.
Drop marker, slip these last worked sts
back onto left-hand needle, pick up yarn
and k across the same 5 sts; then finish
rnd. Continue in stockinette st until piece
measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches from top of ribbing.
Shape top as follows: **1st rnd:** * K 6, k 2
tog. Repeat from * around. **2nd and 3rd
rnds:** K around. **4th rnd:** * K 5, k 2 tog.
Repeat from * around. **5th and 6th rnds:**
K around. **7th rnd:** * K 1, k 2 tog. Re-
peat from * around. **8th rnd:** K around.
9th rnd: K 2 tog all around. Break yarn,
leaving a 6-inch length. Thread a blunt
needle with this strand and slip remain-
ing 8 sts off the needles onto strand. Pull
tightly and darn in end on wrong side.

THUMB . . . Pull out colored thumb
marker and, using No. 4 needles, slip the
5 bottom sts onto 1 needle and the 4 top
sts on to another needle. Attach yarn and
k around, picking up 1 st at both ends
of opening and dividing the 11 sts among
3 needles. K around until Thumb meas-
ures $1\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Now k 2 tog 5 times.
Break yarn and finish as for mitten.

CORD . . . Cut four 2-yard strands of
yarn. Make cord same as cord in direc-
tions No. 5251 on page 7. Sew a mitten
to each end of cord.

MATERIALS:

CHADWICK'S RED HEART BABY
WOOL, 1 ball ($\frac{3}{4}$ oz. ball).

Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Sock Needles,
1 set No. 4.

GAUGE: (PATTERN STITCH) 8 sts make
1 inch. (STOCKINETTE STITCH) 7 sts
make 1 inch; 10 rnds make 1 inch.

Starting at edge of cuff, cast on 48 sts.
Divide sts among 3 needles and join,
being careful not to twist sts. **1st rnd:**
* P 1, k 2. Repeat from * around. **2nd
rnd:** * P 1, k 2, p 1, O, k 2, pass the O
over the last 2 sts knitted. Repeat from *
around. **3rd rnd:** Same as 1st rnd.
4th rnd: * P 1, O, k 2, pass the O over
the last 2 sts knitted, p 1, k 2. Repeat
from * around. These 4 rnds constitute
the cuff pattern. Work in pattern until
piece measures $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. **Next rnd:** K
around, decreasing 16 sts evenly (32
sts). **Following rnd:** * O, k 2 tog. Re-
peat from * around. **Next rnd:** K each
st and each O around.

To complete hand, work as for Mit-
tens No. 5248, starting with paragraph
"Hand."

CORD . . . Cut 2 strands each 1 yard
long. Make cord same as cord in direc-
tions No. 5251 on page 7. Run cord
through eyelets at wrist.

POMPONS . . . Wind yarn 25 times
around index and middle fingers. Break
off. Slip yarn off fingers and tie a strand
securely around center. Cut loops and
trim evenly. Sew a pompon to each end
of cord.
