
Yirdinia Snow Afghans



Rainbow Afghan No. 6006

Nothing lovelier can be imagined than a rainbow flung across the sky after a summer shower. Equally charming in a room is this "Rainbow" Afghan in coral, green and amber.

RAINBOW AFGHAN No. 6006

Size-51" by 72"

MATERIAL

Collingbourne's Afghan-I-Tex yarn lurtrous wool rayon

15 balls Nine Green No. 666

15 balls Scarlet No. 626

15 balls Salmon No. 621

15 balls Dark Salmon No. 646

15 balls Green No. 613

15 balls Yellow No. 641

35 balls Amber No. 684

Virginia Snow Crochet Hook No. 1

Instructions—Chain 200 using amber No. 684, work 1 single crochet in each stitch of chain, turn, chain 3, double crochet 1 row across, turn, chain 1, single crochet across, turn, chain 3, double crochet across. Change to No. 626 red, repeat as above.

Follow the same direction in colors, Nos. 646, 621, 684, 613, 641, 666. Repeat this grouping of

color six times to make Afghan proper length as shown. End with amber No. 684.

Use 684 to crochet single crochet all around edge and finish with fringe as follows: On a cardboard six inches wide, wind 1 ball of each of the colors used in Afghan. Cut through each group of color. Take one thread from each group, 7 in all and tie through every fourth chain across end of Afghan.

RAINBOW BOLSTER PILLOW No. 6006-A

31" long

MATERIAL

Collingbourne's Afghan-I-Tex lustrous wool rayon yarn 14 balls No. 684

4 balls each of the following: No. 621, No. 641, No. 666, No. 646, No. 613, No. 626

Chain 130 with No. 684, work in same manner as Afghan for two sets of color groupings, ending with No. 684. Sew together, leaving 10 in. opening in center to insert inner pillow.

Ends of Pillow: Chain 3 with amber No. 684, join, work 6 single crochet in ring, next row 2 single crochet in each stitch. Now increase enough to keep work flat until it measures $9\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter. Sew ends to pillow with needle and yarn.

Make a tassel for each end of pillow as follows
On a six inch cardboard wind each color around
10 times, tie firmly in center, turn over and cut
through center of yarn. Double one end over the
other covering knot in center of tassel. Tie around
top of tassel one inch from end winding yarn very
tightly and fastening well. Join tassel to pillow
with two inch chain.
