

VERONA SCARF

MATERIAL—7 skeins of white and 5 skeins of color Fleisher's Highland Wool. I pair ambe: needles No. 5.




 $t \text{ stripe} = \frac{3}{4} \text{ inch.}$ 4 stitches = t inch.

With white cast on 125.

Knit I row, purl I row, knit I row, purl I row, knit I row.

*With color, knit I row, purl I row, knit I row, purl I row. With white knit 2 rows, purl I row, knit I row. *Repeat between *'s until scarf is 1 3/4 yds. long.

Fringe—Make loops of 6 threads 15 inches long on each end. Knot 3 threads from each group together about 1 inch from 1st knot.

GERALDINE SCARF

MATERIAL—7 skeins white Fleisher's Shetland Ploss. I pair of amber needles No. $4\frac{1}{2}$.



Cast on 173, knit back.


IST ROW—Knit 5, *over, knit 2, knit 2 together, knit 2*.

2D ROW—Purl 5, *leave yarn front, knit 1, bring yarn forward, purl 1, purl 2 together, purl 2*.

Repeat these 2 rows until scarf measures 13/4 yards.

FRINGE—Loop 6 threads 15 inches long on each stripe. Knot 3 threads from each group together about 1 inch from scarf.
