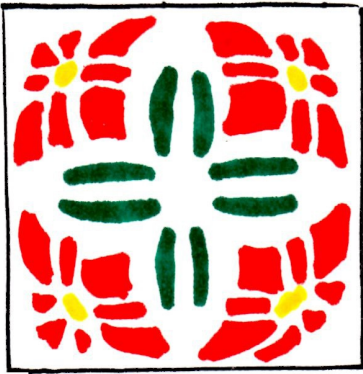


POINSETTIA

There is scarcely a flower grown that has not found its place in a quilt pattern. This lovely poinsettia was one of the first to be used. It was brought back from Hawaii in 1840 by an American missionary.



As Block is made.

Materials Required:

6 yards white

2 1/4 yards red

1 1/2 yards green

Block finish 18" SQ

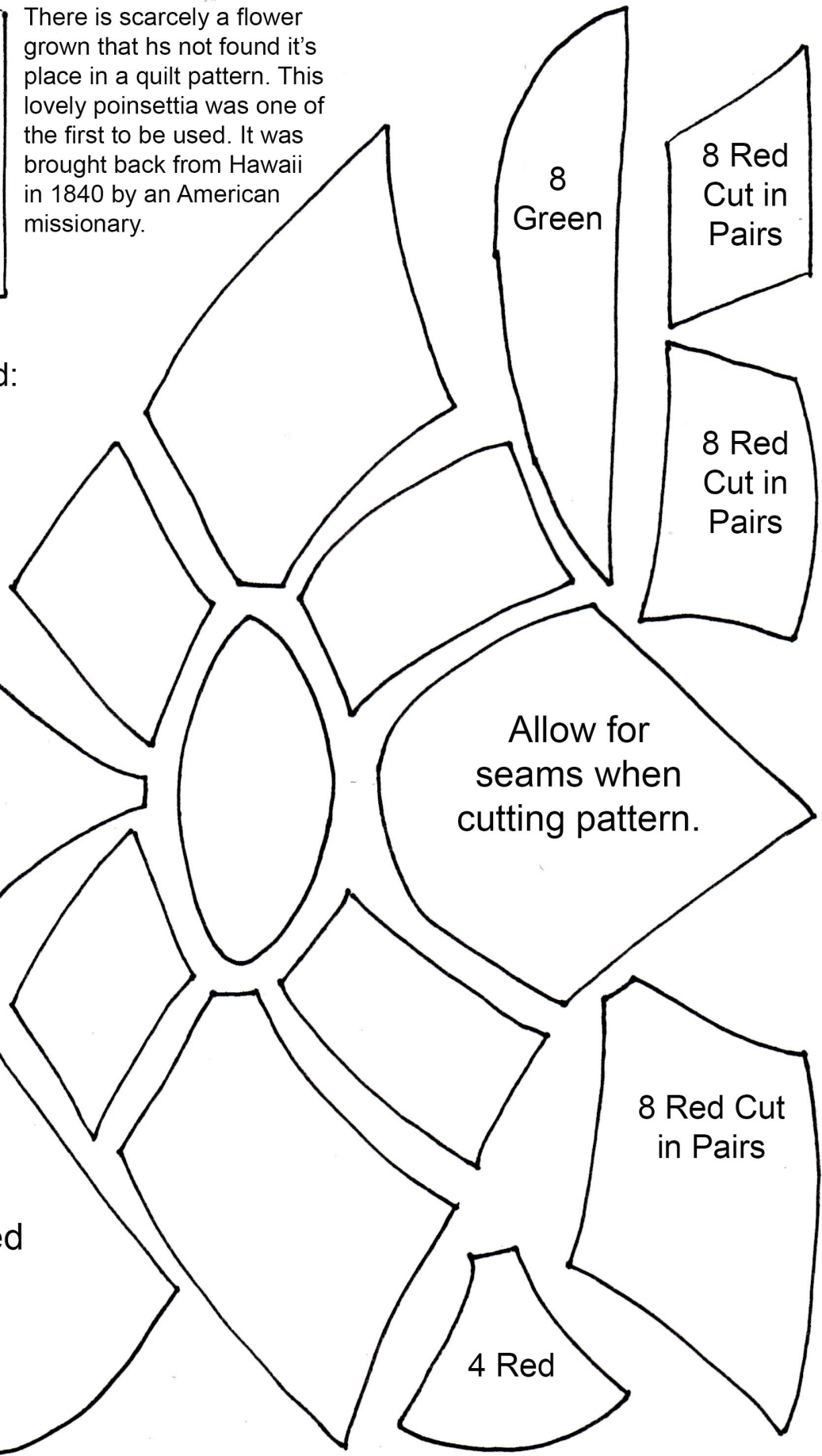
12 pieced blocks

12 plain blocks

12 plain 1/2 blocks

4 plain 1/4 blocks

Set blocks diagonally on quilt
