

minted tea cooler

6 tablesp. lemon juice (about 2 lemons)	15 mint leaves
1½ c. orange juice (about 4 oranges)	3 c. boiling water
2 tablesp. tea	¾ c. powdered sugar
	1 c. grape juice
	Ice

Squeeze juice from lemons and oranges. Combine the fruit skins, tea and mint leaves. Pour boiling water over them, and let steep (stand) until water is cool. Strain off water, pressing liquid from fruit skins. Combine liquid with lemon and orange juices, sugar, and grape juice, and stir until sugar is dissolved. Chill. Serve with ice. Makes 6 c. before adding ice. Corn syrup may replace half the sugar.

Serves 8-10. 1 tablespoon lemon juice and 2 teaspoons grated lemon rind may replace vanilla. A greased 9" x 9" x 2" square cake pan may be substituted for the 9" spring mold. Cool in pan, then cut into squares and serve.

COOKIE JAR POTHOLDER #5517

Materials Required—
AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET AND
KNITTING COTTON, ARTICLE 40

3—160 yd. Balls Yellow and
"STAR" PEARL COTTON, ARTICLE 90, SIZE 5
4—50 yd. Balls Blue will make Jar, Plate and Teapot Holders.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.



With Yellow, ch 21, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in next st of ch, * ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

2nd and 3rd Rows—2 s c in 1st s c (an increase), ch 1, 2 s c in next s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

4th and 5th Rows—Skip 1st s c, 2 s c in next s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, (pattern) repeat from * across row, ch 2, turn.

6th Row—Increase 1 pattern at beginning of row, then work even in pattern to within the last pattern, ch 1, 2 s c in 1st s c of last pattern (an increase), 2 s c in next s c of last pattern, ch 2 to turn each row.

Work 3 rows even in pattern.

10th Row—Increase 1 pattern at beginning and end of row, then work 5 rows even in pattern.

16th Row—Same as 10th row, then work 3 rows even in pattern.

20th Row—Same as 10th row, then work 5 rows even in pattern.

26th Row—Same as 10th row, then work 4 rows even in pattern, break Yellow.

31st Row—Attach Blue and work 10 rows even in pattern, break Blue.

41st and 42nd Rows—With Yellow, decrease 1 pattern at end of each row.

Next 4 Rows—Work even in pattern.

47th and 48th Rows—Same as 41st and 42nd rows, then work 2 rows even.

51st Row—Decrease 1 pattern at beginning and end of row.

52nd Row—Work even in pattern across row, then ch 5 for lid, turn.

53rd Row—2 s c in 3rd st from hook, ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 2 s c in next st of ch, ch 1, then work in pattern across row, ch 5, turn.

54th Row—Work on ch same as opposite side, then work even in pattern across row, ch 2, turn.

55th Row—Work even, ch 2, turn.

56th Row—Skip 1st s c, sl st in each of the next 2 s c, ch 1, 2 s c in next s c, then work in pattern across row to within the last pattern, ch 1, sl st in 1st s c of last pattern, ch 2, turn. Repeat the last row 5 times, break thread. Work another section in same manner.

On top section, with Blue, outline the lid as illustrated and embroider knob on lid using a satin stitch.

With Yellow, working on Blue band, embroider flowers using a lazy daisy stitch with French knot in center.

With Blue, crochet the 2 sections together as follows: attach thread, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip the length of a d c, sl st in next st, repeat from * all around.

HANDLES: With Blue, ch 32 and work 30 s d c on ch (s d c: thread over needle, insert in st, pull through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), break Blue. Attach Yellow at lower edge and work 1 s c in each st. Attach to holder as illustrated.

With Yellow, cover a bone ring with s c and attach to back of holder.

TEAPOT #5518

Work first 51 rows same as jar potholder.

52nd and 53rd Rows—Decrease 1 pattern at beginning and end of each row (10 patterns left).

Next 5 Rows—Work even in pattern, ch 1, turn.

Next Row—1 s c in each s c (20 s c) ch 1, turn.

Next Row—1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

Next 4 Rows—Decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of each row.

Next Row—Decrease 1st s c, s c in next s c, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 2 s c in next st, break thread.

Work another section in same manner.

SPOUT: With Yellow, ch 2, 2 s c in 2nd st from hook, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—1 s c in each s c, ch 1, turn.

3rd Row—Working in s c, increase 1 s c at end of row, ch 1, turn.

4th Row—Increase 1 s c at beginning of row, ch 1, turn.

5th Row—Same as 3rd row, ch 2, turn.

6th Row—S d c in same space, 1 d c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, ch 1, turn.

7th Row—1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, s d c in next st, 2 s d c in last st, ch 2, turn.

8th Row—1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 4 sts, ch 1, turn.

9th Row—1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 2 d c in end st, ch 1, turn.

10th Row—1 s c in each st, break Yellow.

11th Row—With Blue, ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 1 st, 2 s c in end st, ch 2, turn. Work 9 rows even in pattern same as on large section, break Blue.

21st Row—Attach Yellow, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 1 s c in next ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 1 s c in next ch 1, 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in last s c, ch 2, turn.

22nd Row—S d c in same space, 1 s c in each remaining st decreasing 1 s c at end of row, ch 1 turn.

23rd Row—Decrease 1 s c at beginning of row, 1 s c in each s c, increasing 1 s c at end of row, ch 1, turn. Work 2 rows even in s c.

26th, 27th and 28th Rows—Working in s c decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of each row, ch 1, turn.

29th Row—* Insert needle in next st, pull through, repeat from * once, thread over and pull through all loops on needle at one time, break thread. Work another spout in same manner. **HANDLE:** Ch 38 and work same as jar handle.

With Yellow and working on top section embroider flowers in the Blue band same as on jar.

Sew spout to each section.

With Blue, outline lid as illustrated. With Blue, crochet the 2 sections together same as jar holder.

With Blue, cover a bone ring with s c and attach to holder.

PLATE POTHOLDER #5519

With Yellow, ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c in ring, do not join this or the following rows. Place a marker at beginning of each row.

2nd Row—2 s c in each s c.

3rd Row—* 1 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around.

4th Row—Working in s c, increase in every 3rd s c.

5th Row—Increase in every 4th s c.

6th Row—Increase in every 5th s c, then work 1 row even.

8th Row—Increase in every 6th s c.

9th Row—Increase in every 7th s c, then work 1 row even.

11th Row—Increase in every 8th s c.

12th Row—Increase in every 9th s c, then work 1 row even.

14th Row—Increase in every 10th s c.

15th Row—Increase in every 11th s c.

16th Row—Increase in every 12th s c.

17th Row—Increase in every 8th s c, then work 3 rows even.

21st Row—Increase in every 9th s c, sl st in each of the next 2 s c to even row, break Yellow.

22nd Row—Attach Blue, ch 1, 1 s c in same space, 1 s c in next s c, * ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from * all around, sl st in ch 1 to join.

23rd Row—Ch 1, skip 1st s c, 2 s c in next s c, * ch 1, skip the ch 1 and 1 s c, 2 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around, ch 1, sl st in 1st ch 1 to join. Repeat the last row 6 times, break Blue.

30th Row—Attach Yellow and work 1 s c in each s c and 1 s c in each ch 1, join, break thread. Work another section in same manner. On top section, with Yellow embroider flowers as illustrated, using a lazy daisy stitch with French knots in the center and working in the Blue stripe only. With Blue, embroider a large flower in center using a lazy daisy st with Yellow French knot in center.

With Blue, crochet the 2 sections together as follows: * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 s c, sl st in next s c, repeat from * all around. With Blue, cover a bone ring in s c and attach to holder.
