

Bangle Jacket

Sizes: Small, Medium, Large Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED or DAWN "SAYELLE"\*

5 (6, 6) - 4 oz. skeins White 30 (31, 31) Pkgs. Iris Crystal Bangles (100 bangles per pkg.)

Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW

**GAUGE:** 3 sc = 1 inch

Directions are given for Small size. Changes for Medium and Large sizes are given in parentheses.

BACK: Ch 52 (56, 60), sc in 2nd st from hook and in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn 51 (55, 59) s c. 1st BANGLE ROW: S c in 1st st, \* insert hook in next st and through 1 bangle, yarn over and complete sc, sc in next st, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn. 2nd ROW: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROW: Work a bangle in 1st st, \* s c in next st, work a bangle in next st, repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn. 4th ROW: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn. Repeat last 4 rows for 12 (13, 14) inches from beg or length desired to underarm. SHAPE ARMHOLES: Working in pattern sl st across 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 39 (43, 47) sts. Work in pattern until armholes measure 7 ( $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 8) inches from underarm.

SHAPE SHOULDERS: SI st across 5 sts at beg of next 4 rows, then sI st across 4 (5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows, cut yarn, 11 (13, 17) sts remain for back of neck. LEFT FRONT: Ch 28 (30, 32), and work same as back to armhole. SHAPE ARMHOLE: SI st across 1st 6 sts, work in pattern across remainder of row. Then continue until armhole measures 5½ inches ending at neck edge. SHAPE NECK: SI st across 4 (5, 7) sts, then dec 1 st at neck edge every 2nd row 3 times ending at shoulder edge. SHAPE SHOULDER: SI st across 1st 5 sts. Complete row.

**NEXT ROW:** Work even. Repeat last 2 rows once. **NEXT ROW:** SI st across 4 (5, 5) sts, cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT: Work same as Left Front reversing all shaping omitting sts at Armhole edge and sl st across neck edge. SLEEVES: Ch 42 (46, 50). Work same as Back until Sleeve measures 15½ (16, 16½) inches, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Sew side and shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams leaving about 2 inches open at underarm. Sew sleeves in position sewing sleeve seam opening to underarm. With right side facing, attach yarn at lower right front corner, and working up front 1 s c in each row, 1 s c in each st at neck edge, 1 s c in each row along side of neck, 1 s c in each st across back of neck, and complete other front to correspond, ch 1, turn. Work 1 row of sl sts around front and neck edge working one bangle in every 2nd st.
