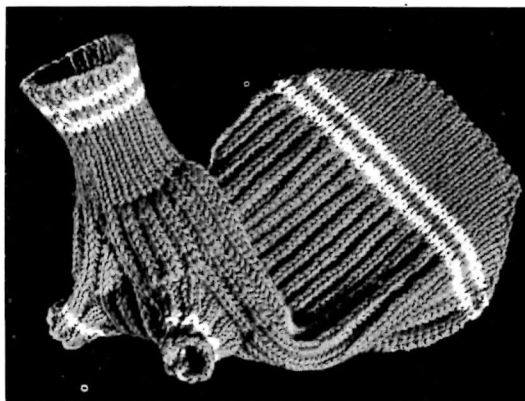


Dog's Sweater A-298



Fits Sizes 8" to 20"
(Measure from base of
neck to tail)

COATS & CLARK'S "RED HEART" KNITTING WORSTED, 4 Ply ("Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skeins):

Sizes	8	10	12	14	16	18	20
-------	---	----	----	----	----	----	----

No. 848 Skipper Blue.....Ounces 2 2 3 4 4 5 5
and 1/3 oz. of No. 1 White for all Sizes.

Knitting needles, 1 pair No. 6 and 1 set Double-pointed needles No. 6.

GAUGE: 7 pattern sts = 2 inches; 11 rows = 1 inch.

Body Chest Size (In Inches) 10½ 11½ 13 14½ 16 17½ 19
Length of Back (excluding collar)..... 8 10 12 14 16 18 20

Starting at tail end, with Blue and single-pointed needles cast onStitches 22 24 28 32 36 40 44
1st row: Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing across to last st, sl 1. 2nd row: K 1, inc 1 st in next st, work in ribbing as established to within last 2 sts, inc 1 st in next st, sl 1. Repeat 2nd row until there areStitches 30 32 36 42 46 50 54
Next row: Work in ribbing as established across, slipping last st. Repeat last row until total length isInches 1½ 1½ 2 2 2 3 3
Drop Blue, attach White. Next 7 rows: Keeping in ribbing, work 2 rows White, 2 rows Blue, 2 rows White and 1 row Blue. Continue with Blue only. Next row: K across, increasing 1 st at end of row. Now work in pattern as follows: 1st row: K 1, * k 1 in the st directly below next st on left-hand needle and slip off the st from left-hand needle—

a knit 1 below made; k 1. Repeat from * across. 2nd row: K 2, * k 1 below, k 1. Repeat from * across, ending with k 2 instead of k 1. Repeat last 2 rows for pattern. Work in pattern until total length isInches	4	5	6	7	8½	9½	10
Now inc 1 st at both ends of every row until there are on needleStitches	37	39	45	51	57	61	67
Place a marker in first and last st of last row to indicate start of seam. Work even until total length isInches ending with 2nd row.	5	6½	8	9½	11	12	13

LEG OPENING . . . 1st row (Right side): Work across nextStitches 4 4 4 6 6 6 6
bind off nextStitches 3 3 3 3 4 4 4
work in pattern across to within last.....Stitches 7 7 7 9 10 10 10
bind off nextStitches 3 3 3 3 4 4 4
work across lastStitches 4 4 4 6 6 6 6
Work in pattern over the last group of stitches only forInches ending with a wrong side row. Break off and fasten. Slip sts onto stitch holder. With wrong side of work facing attach yarn to first st of next group and complete as for first group. Complete last group as for first group but do not break yarn. Slip sts from stitch holders onto free needle.

Next row: Work in pattern across, casting on the same number of sts over each set of bound-off sts. There are on needle.....Stitches 37 39 45 51 57 61 67
Keeping in pattern, dec 1 st at both ends of next row and everyRow 2nd 3rd 4th 4th 5th 5th 5th
until there remainStitches 33 35 39 45 49 53 57
Work even until total length is.....Inches 8 10 12 14 16 18 20
ending with a right side row.
Next row: K across, increasing evenly....Stitches 7 9 9 7 7 7 7

COLLAR . . . Work in ribbing over these
Stitches 40 44 48 52 56 60 64
Inches 1½ 1¾ 2 2½ 2½ 2½ 2½
then work 2 rows White, 2 rows Blue, 2 rows White and 2 rows Blue. Bind off loosely in ribbing.

LEG . . . With Blue, double-pointed needles and right side of work facing, pick up and k around one leg opening.....Stitches 27 27 30 33 33 36 39

Divide sts evenly among 3 needles and work in rnds as follows: Next 3 rnds: * K 1, p 2. Repeat from * around. 4th rnd: * K 1, p 2 tog. Repeat from * around. Drop Blue. Attach White. Next 2 rnds: Work in k 1, p 1 ribbing around.

Then with Blue repeat last 2 rnds. Bind off loosely in ribbing. Work same as other leg.

Block. Starting at markers sew center seam. Turn back collar.
