#### GAUGE:

8 Shells =  $2\frac{1}{8}$  inches 7 rows = 1 inch \*=STAR Abbreviations, see page 15. NOTE: Work stitches tightly so that finished Tie will be firm. Keep to gauge. With A ch 37, 3 dc in 5th ch from hook, \* skip 3 chs, sc in next ch, ch 2, 3 dc in same ch as last sc; rpt from

STAR 6 times, sc in last ch (8 Shells; 21/8 ins.). Row 2-Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, \* sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp just used; rpt from STAR 6 times, sc in last sp. Rpt row 2 four times. Fasten off. Row 7-Turn, with B slip st in first sc, ch 4, 3 dc in same first sc, sc in next ch-2 sp, work 7 more B Shells as before ending with

sc in last sp. Row 8-Rpt row 2, fasten off. Row 9-Turn, with A slip st in first sc, ch 4, 3 dc in same sc, sc in next sp, finish row as before. Rpt row 2 five times. Fasten off. Rpt last 8 rows for pattern until 16 ins. (about 112 rows) from beginning. Continuing in same color pattern, finish Tie as for Tie No. 7119, page 12.

8 Shells= $2\frac{1}{8}$  inches 7 rows=1 inch \*=STAR  $\dagger$ =DAGGER

NOTE: Work stitches tightly so that finished Tie will be firm. Keep to gauge. With A ch 37, 3 dc in 5th ch from hook, skip 3 chs, sc in next ch, † drop A to back (wrong side) of work, cut a 15-yard length of B and tie to A (close to work), with B yo and draw B thru loop on hook (thus changing from A to B), with B ch 1, working over A, 3 dc in same ch as last sc, skip 3 chs, sc over A in next ch, drop B to back (wrong side), with A yo and draw A thru loop on hook (thus changing from B to A), with A ch 1, not working over B, \* 3 dc in same ch as last sc, skip 3 chs, sc in next ch †, ch 2; rpt from

STAR 3 times ending last rpt with sc; rpt between DAGGERS once (8 Shells). Row 2-Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, sc in next ch-2 sp, † drop A to front (wrong side) of work, cut a 15yard length of C and tie to A as before, with C yo and draw C thru loop on hook, with C ch 1, working over A, 3 dc in ch-2 sp just used, sc over A in next ch-2 sp, drop C to front (wrong side), with A yo and draw A thru loop on hook, ch 1, not working over C, \* 3 dc in sp just used †, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2; rpt from STAR 3 times ending last rpt with sc; rpt between DAGGERS once, sc in last sp. Row 3-Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, sc in next ch-2 sp, t drop A to wrong side, with C ch 2, 3 dc over A in sp just used, sc over A in next sp, drop C to wrong side, not working over C, with A \* ch 2, 3 dc

in sp just used †, sc in next sp; rpt from STAR three times; rpt between DAG-GERS once, sc in last sp. Row 4-Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, sc in next sp, † drop A to wrong side, extend nearest B strand to hook and ch 2, 3 dc over A in sp just used, sc over A in next sp, drop B to wrong side, not working over B, with A \* ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used †, sc in next sp; rpt from STAR 3 times; rpt between DAGGERS once, sc in last sp. Row 5-Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, sc in next sp, with B ch 2, working as before work 1 B Shell, 4 A Shells, 1 B Shell, 1 A Shell, sc in last sp. Row 6-Work 1 A Shell, 1 C Shell, 4 A Shells, 1 C Shell, 1 A Shell. Rpt rows 3 to 6 inclusive until 16 ins. (about 112 rows) from beginning. Cut off B and C. With A finish Tie as for Tie No. 7119, page 12.

MATERIALS — D·M·C PEARL, Art. 116D, size 8. 4 balls of Maroon No. 815 or Navy No. 823 or Red No. 498 or Brown No. 898 or Grey No. 318 or Yellow No. 745 or Skipper Blue No. 796 or any other desired D·M·C Color

GAUGE: 8 Shells =  $2\frac{1}{6}$  inches 7 rows = 1 inch \* = STAR Abbreviations, see page 15. NOTE: Work stitches tightly so that finished Tie will be firm. Keep to gauge. Ch 37, 3 dc in 5th ch from hook, \* skip 3 chs, sc in next ch, ch 2, 3 dc in same ch as last sc; rpt from STAR 6 times, sc in last ch (8 Shells;  $2\frac{1}{8}$  ins.). Row 2 --Ch 4, turn, 3 dc in first sc, \* sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in ch-2 sp just used; rpt from STAR 6 times, sc in last sp. Rpt row 2 until 16 ins. (about Steel Crochet Hook, Size 10.

112 rows) from beginning. FINISHING—Next row—Dec. row— Work 3 Shells ending with 3 dc of 3rd Shell, draw up a loop in each of next 2 ch-2 sps, yo, draw thru all 3 loops on hook (a dec. made), ch 2, 3 dc in last ch-2 sp just used, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used, complete row as before (7 Shells in row). Work on 7 Shells for 11/4 ins. Work a dec. row decreasing a Shell at approx. center as before (6 Shells). Work for 11/4 ins. Work a dec. row (5 Shells). Work for 21/4 ins. Work a dec. row (4 Shells). Work for  $2\frac{1}{4}$  ins. Work a dec. row (3 Shells). Work for  $9\frac{1}{2}$  ins. not stretched (for Neckband). Inc. row— Work 1 Shell ending with 1 sc in first sp, ch 2, 3 dc in same sp, sc in 2nd dc of next Shell, ch 2, 3 dc in same dc just used, sc in next ch-2 sp, finish row in usual manner (4 Shells). Work for  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Work an inc. row (5 Shells). Work for  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. Work an inc. row (6 Shells). Work for 8 ins. Fasten off. Darn in all ends neatly. Pin Tie to shape and steam. With ribbon line entire Tie or just Neckband as desired.

## GAUGE:

8 Shells =  $2\frac{1}{4}$  inches 7 rows = 1 inch \*=STAR Abbreviations, see page 15. NOTE: Work stitches tightly so that finished Tie will be firm. Keep to gauge. With A ch 38, 2 dc in 5th ch from hook, 2 dc in next ch, \* skip 3 chs, sc in next ch, ch 2, 3 dc in same ch as last sc; rpt from STAR 6 times, sc in last ch (8 Shells; 21/4 ins.). Row 2 -Ch 4, turn, 2 dc in first sc, \* sc in next ch-2 sp, drop A to back (wrong side) of work, cut a 11/2-yard length of B and tie to A (close to work), with B yo and draw B thru loop on hook (thus changing from A to B), with B ch 1, 2 dc in ch-2 sp just used, yo, draw up a loop in same sp, yo, thru 2 loops (holding 2 loops on hook), drop B to wrong side, with A yo and draw A thru 2 loops on hook (thus changing from B to A in 3rd dc), with A sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used, sc in next ch-2 sp, drop A to wrong side, cut a 11/2-yard length of C and tie to A as before, with C yo and draw C thru loop on hook (changing to C), with C ch 1, 2 dc in sp just used, yo, draw up a loop in same sp, yo, thru 2 loops (holding 2 loops on hook), drop C to wrong side, with A yo and draw A thru 2 loops on hook (changing to A in 3rd dc) \*, with A sc in next sp, ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used; rpt between STARS once; end, sc in last dc of last Shell, sc in last sp (8 Shells). Row 3-Ch 4, turn, 2 dc in first sc, 2 dc in next sc, \* sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used; rpt from STAR 6 times, sc in last sp. Row 4-Ch 4, turn, 2 dc in first sc, sc in next ch-2 sp, \* ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used, sc in next ch-2 sp, drop A to wrong side, extend closest C strand to hook, draw C thru loop on hook, with C ch 1, working over extended strand, 2 dc in ch-2 sp just used, yo, draw up a loop in same sp, yo, thru 2 loops, drop C to wrong side, with A yo and draw A thru 2 loops on hook, with A sc in next sp, ch 2, 3 dc in sp just used \*, sc in next sp, drop A to wrong side, extend next B strand to hook, draw B thru loop on hook, ch 1, working over extended strand, 1 B Shell in ch-2 sp just used changing to A in 3rd dc, drop B to wrong side, with A sc in next ch-2 sp; rpt between STARS once, end as row 2. Rpt row 3. Row 6-Work as for row 4 only work 1 A Shell, 1 C Shell, cut off this strand of C, 1 A Shell, 1 B Shell, 1 A Shell, 1 C Shell, 1 A Shell, tie a 11/2-yard length of B as before and work 1 B Shell. Rpt row 3. Row 8-Working as before, work 2 A Shells, 1 B, 1 A, 1 C, 1 A, 1 B, 1 A. Rpt row 3. Row 10-1 A, 1 B Shell, cut off this strand of B, 1 A, 1 C, 1 A, 1 B, 1 A, tie a 11/2-yard length of C and work 1 C Shell. Rpt rows 3 to 10 inclusive until 16 ins. (about 112 rows) from beginning. Cut off B and C. With A finish Tie as for Tie No. 7119, page 12.
