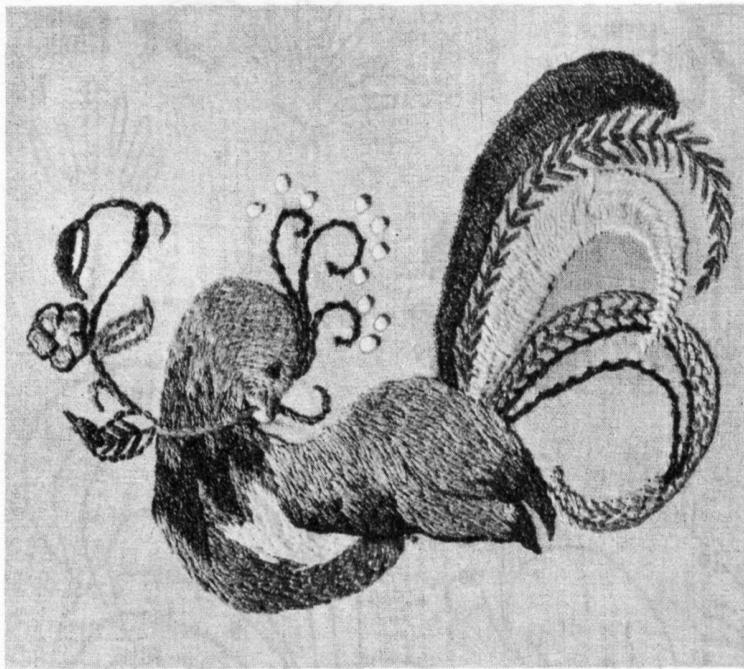


Crewel Embroidered Bird of Paradise Pattern

Crewel EMBROIDERED Bird of Paradise

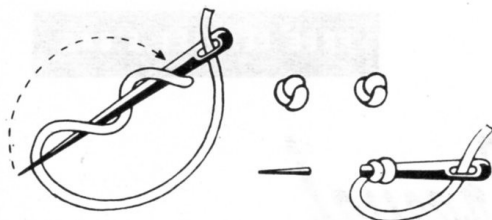
COATS & CLARK'S "O.N.T." SIX STRAND FLOSS, Art. C. 11: 1 skein each of No. 24 Lt. Oriental Blue, No. 24-A Oriental Blue, No. 24-B Dk. Oriental Blue, No. 48-A Dk. Hunter's Green, No. 75-A Tropic Orange and No. 184-A Shaded Lt. Yellows.

Milwards Embroidery Needle No. 7.

EMBROIDERY: Use 3 strands throughout. Follow diagram and key for stitches and colors for all marked areas.

HOW TO APPLY MULTI-TRANSFER DESIGN

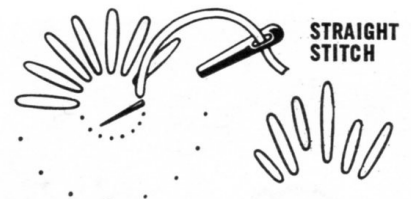
Pin cloth tightly over ironing board to protect it in case transfer ink penetrates fabric. Smooth fabric on ironing board. Cut out transfer. Pin transfer in place, face down. With iron at "Medium" heat, apply iron gently but firmly for 2 or 3 seconds. If necessary, increase time slightly for additional impressions. Too much heat might scorch fabric and spoil re-use of transfer. Transfer may be used up to 6 times.



FRENCH KNOTS: Draw point of needle through fabric to right side; wind thread around needle three times. Insert needle in fabric and pull through to wrong side, holding twists in place with thumb of left hand.
