

What You Need:

ROYAL SOCIETY SIX CORD CORDICHET

Small Ball, size 20:

1 ball will make about 8 pulls.

Steel Crochet Hook No. 8 or 9.

A bone ring about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in diameter at outer circumference for each pull.



No. 1-45 B

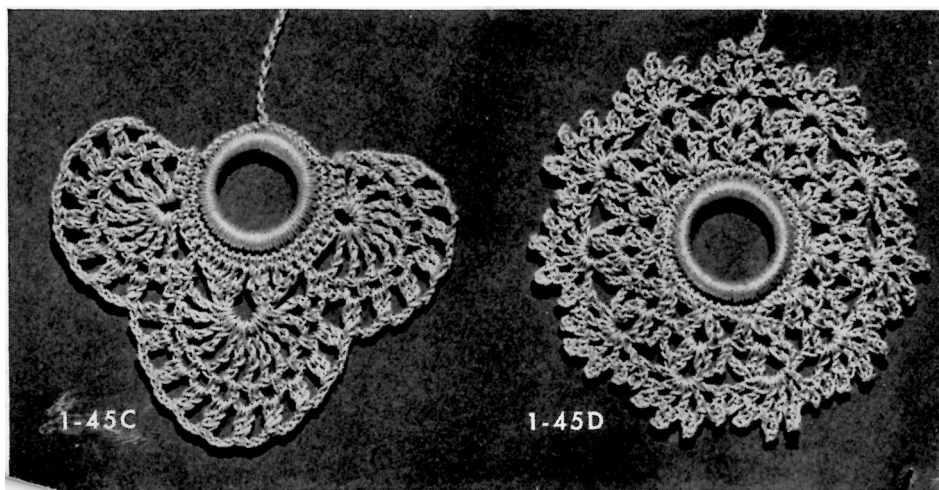
1st rnd: 50 sc over bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc made.
2nd rnd: Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st and in each sc around. Sl st in 1st sc made.
3rd rnd: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, sk 4 sc, 2 dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in 3rd st of ch-3.
4th rnd: Sl st in next dc; in each sp around make sc, h dc, dc, 2 tr, ch 5, 2 tr, dc, h dc and sc. Sl st in 1st sc made.
5th rnd: Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st, sc in next 4 sts, * in loop make (2 sc, ch 5) 3 times and 2 sc; sc in next 5 sts of this scallop and in the 1st 5 sts of next scallop. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 1st sc made. Fasten off.

Make cord as for No. 1-45 A and sew to pull as in illustration.

No. 1-45 A

1st rnd: 50 sc over bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc made.
2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 8, (sk 1 sc, holding back on hook the last loop of each d tr make d tr in next sc) 4 times; ch 8, sk 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 8; sl st in 1st sc made.
3rd rnd: Make 10 sc over each ch-8 around.
4th rnd: Sk 1 sc, * sc in next 10 sc, ch 5, sc in 5th ch from hook (p made), make 2 more p's, sc in 1st ch of 1st p, sc in same place where the sc immediately preceding p's was made, sc in next 8 sc, sk 1 sc on this point and 1 sc on next point. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 1st sc made. Fasten off.

CORD . . . Cut two strands of thread each 20 inches long. Twist these strands tightly. Now double these strands and give them a second twist in the opposite direction. Knot free ends. Sew one end to pull as in illustration.



No. 1-45 C

1st rnd: 50 sc over bone ring. Sl st in 1st sc made. Now work in rows (back and forth) as follows: **1st row:** Sc in same place as sl st and in next 29 sc. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in 1st 5 sc, ch 5, sc in next 6 sc, h dc in next sc, dc in next sc, tr in next 2 sc, ch 5, tr in next 2 sc, dc in next sc, h dc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc, ch 5, sc in next 5 sc. Ch 1, turn. **3rd row:** In ch-5 loop make 9 tr with ch 1 between, ch 1, sk 5 sc, sc in next sc, ch 2, in ch-5 sp make 12 tr with ch 1 between, ch 2, sk 4 sts, sc in next st, ch 1, in next ch-5 make 9 tr with ch 1 between, ch 1, sl st in last sc. Turn. **4th row:** Sc in sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) 9 times; sc in next sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) 12 times; sc in next sp, (ch 3, sc in next sp) 9 times. Turn. **5th row:** Sl st in next 2 ch, sc in sp, * ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc make 2 dc in next loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made).

Repeat from * 6 more times; sk 2 loops, cluster in next loop, (ch 3, cluster in next loop) 9 times; sk 2 loops, cluster in next loop, (ch 3, cluster in next loop) 6 times; ch 3, sc in next loop, sl st in last 2 ch of loop. Fasten off.

Make cord as for No. 1-45 A and sew to pull as in illustration.

No. 1-45 D

1st rnd: 55 sc over bone ring, sl st in 1st sc made. **2nd rnd:** Ch 1, sc in same place as sl st and in each sc around. Sl st in 1st sc. **3rd rnd:** Ch 3, in same place as sl st make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc, * sk 4 sc, in next sc make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made). Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in top st of ch-3. **4th rnd:** Sl st in next dc and in next sp, ch 3, in same sp make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc; * ch 3, sc between shells, ch 3, shell over shell. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, sl st in top st of ch-3 first made. **5th rnd:** Sl st in next dc and in next sp, ch 7, sc in 4th ch from hook (p made); in same sp make (dc, p) 4 times and dc; in sp of each shell make (dc, p) 5 times and dc. Sl st in 3rd st of ch-7 first made.

Make cord as for No. 1-45 A, and sew to pull as in illustration.
