



The "Star Spangled" Bonnet

Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
The Famous "PURITAN" STAR SPANGLED
MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 40

4 balls Blue Spangle for hat.
 8 balls for bag or

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2 balls Blue for hat.
 5 balls for bag.

Gauge for hat using single strand of thread:
 7 sts = 1 inch.

Gauge for bag using double strand of thread:
 11 sts = 2 inches.

Steel crochet hook No. 5 for hat.
 Steel crochet hook No. 2 for bag.
 Bicycle clip.

85 pearl beads and 11 daisy sequins for hat.
 42 pearl beads and 6 daisy sequins for bag.
 ½ yd. material for lining.

HAT

Starting at front of hat with single strand of thread and No. 5 hook ch 90 (about 13½ inches), s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining st of ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row: S c in 1st s c, d c in same space (an increase), s c in next s c, * d c in next s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * across row working 1 d c, 1 s c in last st (an increase), ch 1, turn.

3rd Row: D c in 1st s c, * s c in next d c, d c in next s c

(pattern), repeat from * across row, ch 1, turn.

4th Row: 1 d c, 1 s c in 1st st (increase), d c in next s c, * s c in next d c, d c in next s c, repeat from * across row working 1 s c, 1 d c in last st (increase), ch 1, turn.

5th Row: S c in 1st st, * d c in next s c, s c in next d c, repeat from * across row, ch 1, turn.

6th Row: 1 s c, 1 d c in 1st st, s c in next d c, * d c in next s c, s c in next d c, repeat from * across row working 1 d c, 1 s c in last st, ch 1, turn. Repeat from 3rd through 6th rows until piece measures 5½ inches from beginning measuring at center, turn.

Next 16 Rows: Keeping pattern uniform decrease 2 sts at beginning and end of each row (to decrease: sl st in next st, pull up a loop in each of the next 2 sts, thread over and work off all loops at one time, work in pattern to within last 3 sts, work next 2 sts off as 1 st, omit last st), ch 1, turn. Keeping pattern uniform decrease 1 st at beginning of each row until 4 sts remain, cut thread. Press under a damp cloth.

EDGE: Attach thread about 3 inches from 1st decreasing row, ch 2, s d c in same space (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), skip ⅜ inch space, s c in next space, * ch 2, s d c in s c just made, skip ⅜ inch space, s c in next space, repeat from * around long point of hat working to same space at opposite side, sl st to corner, work edge down shaped side, across front and up opposite shaped side to corner, cut thread.

Cut material ¼ inch larger all around than hat. Turn edge under and slip stitch in position.

Fold hat in half and sew together where edge was omitted. Trim with pearls and sequins as illustrated.

BAG

Using a double strand of thread and No. 2 hook, ch 2, 8 s c in 2nd st from hook, do not join this or following rounds. Place a marker at beginning of each round.

2nd Round: 2 s c in each s c.

3rd and 4th Rounds: Working in s c, increase in every other s c in each round. Work 1 round even.

6th Round: Increase in every 3rd s c. Work 1 round even. Repeat the last 2 rounds.

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10th Round: Increase in every 4th s c. Work 2 rounds even.

13th Round: Increase in every 5th s c. Work 2 rounds even.

16th Round: Increase in every 6th s c. Work 1 round even.

18th Round: Increase in every 8th st (126 s c). Work 1 round even, sl st in next st to even round, turn.

20th Round: 1 s c in each st picking up entire st by inserting hook around entire st, join, turn.

21st Round: S c in 1st st, * d c in next st, s c in next st, repeat from * all around ending with d c in last st, join in 1st s c, ch 1, turn.

22nd Round: S c in 1st d c, * d c in next s c, s c in next d c, repeat from * all around ending with d c in last st, join, ch 1, turn. Repeat the last round until work measures $5\frac{3}{4}$ inches from 20th round ending on right side, do not turn.

Next Round: BEADING: Ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 sts, * ch 3, skip 3 sts, 1 tr c in each of the next 3 sts, repeat from * all around ending with ch 3, skip 3 sts, join in 4th st of ch.

Next Round: S c in same space, * d c in next tr c, s c in next tr c, d c in next st of ch, s c in next st of ch, d c in next st of ch, s c in next tr c, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, join, turn.

Next Row: 1st PETAL: * S c in next d c, d c in next s c, repeat from * 9 times, s c in next d c, ch 1, turn. Keeping pattern even decrease 1 st at beginning and end of each row until 3 sts remain, cut thread.

2nd PETAL: With wrong side toward you attach thread in next st of last complete round, ch 3, * s c in next d c, d c in next s c, repeat from * 9 times, ch 1, turn. Keeping pattern even, decrease 1 st at beginning and end of each row until 3 sts remain, cut thread.

3rd PETAL: With wrong side toward you, attach thread in next st of last complete round, s c in same space, * d c in next s c, s c in next d c, repeat from * 9 times, ch 1, turn. Finish same as 1st petal.

4th PETAL: Same as 2nd petal.

5th PETAL: Same as 3rd petal.

6th PETAL: Same as 2nd petal. Without cutting thread work a row of s c around each petal, join, cut thread.

DRAW STRING: Using a double strand of thread, crochet a ch about 32 inches long, sl st in 2nd st from hook, 1 sl st in each remaining st of ch, cut thread. Work another string in same manner. Lace through beading starting each string from opposite side. Finish with metal points as illustrated or sew ends together. Trim with pearls and sequins same as on hat. Line if desired.
