

#### APRON E-108

COATS & CLARK'S O.N.T. SIX STRAND FLOSS, Art. C. 11: 1 skein each of No. 76 China Blue, No. 1 White and No. 59-B Dk. Rose.

## Milwards Tapestry Needle No. 22.

- 1 yard huck toweling, 17 inches wide.
- 2 yards matching grosgrain ribbon, 1 inch wide.

Design is worked on horizontal loop side of fabric at lower end of apron. Make a narrow hem along 2 short sides and 1 long side. Mark center of apron 41/2 inches up from lower edge for starting point.

Embroidery: Following diagram on page 26, work as for Embroidery of E-109 on page 25. Gather top edge in to 16 inches and sew grosgrain ribbon in place for waistband, leaving 28 inches free at each side for ties.

### COATS & CLARK'S O.N.T. SIX STRAND FLOSS,

Art. C. 11: 1 skein each of No. 201-A Lt. Aquatone and No. 81-A Colonial Brown; and 2 skeins of No. 75-A Tropic Orange.


Milwards Tapestry Needle No. 22.

Huck towel.

Design is worked on vertical loop side of fabric at one end of towel only. Mark center of towel 5½ inches up from lower edge for starting point.

Embroidery: Use 6 strands throughout.

Cut 1 length of each color 3 yards long. Starting at center, with color No. 1 draw half the length through the center loop leaving the end free to be worked later. Follow top row of diagram from center to the left edge. Draw needle back through ½ inch of design to fasten off securely. With free end of thread follow diagram from center to right edge. Fasten as before. Repeating pattern from A to B for left side and from B to A for right side, complete design as shown in Diagram on page 26.







