



Design No. 34—SACHET "Rosebud"

MATERIALS—DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton Size 10 in Salmon Rose. Lily SKYTONE in Shaded Greens. Crochet hook size 7.

ROSE—In Salmon Rose, ch 2, 5 sc in 1st st. In back loops, (2 sc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc) until there are 20 sc in row. (2 sc in next, sc in 5 sc) 5 times. (2 sc in next sc, sc in 11 sc) until 1½" long. Sl st in next sc, (ch 3 and in both loops, dc around, sl st in 3-ch) twice. Ch 3, (dc in 6 dc, dc in next 2 dc worked off together into a Cluster) around and join. Repeat this row once. Ch 3, (dc in 4 dc, dc in 2 dc for a Cluster) around and join. Repeat once. Stuff hard with cotton in which is rolled a tsp. of sachet powder. Ch 1, (sc in 2 sts, sk next st until 8 sc remain, close with sl st. Fasten off. **PETAL**—Ch 7, sk 4 sts, (2 dc in next st 3 times. (Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in last dc, dc across, 3 dc in end 3-ch) 4 times. (Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc and end ch) twice. Ch 4, turn, sk last dc, dc in next 3 dc for a Cluster, dc across with dc in last 4 dc made into a Cluster 3 times. Ch 3, turn, sk Cluster, dc in 5 dc for a Cluster, ch 4, sl st in Cluster. Fasten off. Make 4. **IN SHADED GREENS:—STEM**—Cut 7 strands 10" long and double for a cord. Make a 4½" ch, sl st in folded end of cord, ch 1, and over cord, 1 sc in each ch st. Fasten off. **CALYX**—Ch 9, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring. In back

loops, (sc in next sc, 2 sc in next) 6 times. (Sc in 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) 6 times. Sc in 48 sc. (Sk 1 sc, sc in 2 sc) until 15 sc remain, 1 sl st. * Ch 15, sl st in 5th st from hook, (2 hdc, 3 dc, 4 tr) on ch, a 2-dc-Cluster in next ch st, sl st in next 3d sc. Repeat from * 4 times. Fasten off. **LEAF**—Ch 15, sk last st, * (1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc) on ch, (tr in 2 sts, 2 tr in next) twice, 2 dc and 1 hdc on ch, * (2 sc, a 4-ch p and 1 sc) in end st. Repeat from * to * on other side of ch. Sl st in 1st sc, ch 1 and fasten off. Make 5. **STEM**—Ch 30, 29 sc on ch. Sew 1 leaf to end of stem and 2 leaves on each side. Starch back of leaves, stems, calyx and rose petals. When dry, tack petals around bottom of bud. Pass stem up thru calyx and tack to bud. Stuff calyx base with cotton and tack calyx petals to bud. Tack leaf to stem.
