## Block At a Time Afghan D-216 Knitting Pattern



### "BLOCK AT A TIME" AFGHAN D-216

Afghan measures 44 x 55 inches.

**COATS & CLARK RED HEART® WORSTED Hand Knitting Yarn**, Art. E.267, 4 Ply (Ready to Use Pull-Out Skeins): 12 ounces each of No. 356 Taupe, No. 255 Burnt Orange, No. 245 Orange and No. 602 Dk. Gold.

Knitting Needles, 1 pair No. 8.

**GAUGE:** 4 sts = 1"; 8 rows = 1".

Each block measures 5½" square.

**Be sure to check your gauge before starting afghan. Use any size needles that will obtain the stitch gauge above.**

**First Block (Make 20):** With Dk. Gold cast on one st, turn. **Row 1:** K in front and in back of first st—one st increased. **Row 2:** K 1, inc one st in last st—3 sts. **Row 3:** K to last st, inc one st in last st. **Rows 4-33:** Repeat Row 3. There are 34 sts on last row. Break off Dk. Gold, attach Orange. **Row 34:** Insert needle through back of first 2 sts, k 2 tog; \* yo, k 2 tog through back of next 2 sts. Rep from \* across—33 sts. **Row 35:** K to last 2 sts, k 2 tog. **Rows 36-66:** Rep Row 35. One st remains on last row. Break off and draw end through remaining st.

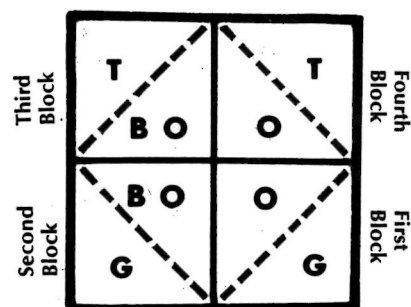
**Second Block (Make 20):** Work as for First Block, using Dk. Gold for Rows 1-33 and Burnt Orange for Rows 34-66.

**Third Block (Make 20):** Work as for First Block, using Taupe for Rows 1-33 and Burnt Orange for Rows 34-66.

**Fourth Block (Make 20):** Work as for First Block, using Taupe for Rows 1-33 and Orange for Rows 34-66.

Following Diagram A at right for position of colors and direction of rows, sew a First, Second, Third and Fourth Block together to form a square. Sew 19 more squares in same way; sew squares together as indicated in Diagram B.

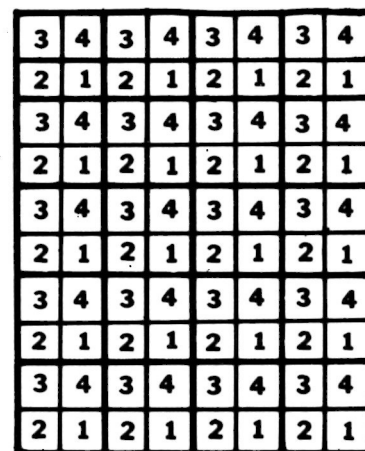
