



pinwheel sandwiches



Freshly baked unsliced
white bread
Butter or margarine

Stuffed olives
(optional)

Remove the crusts from a loaf of bread. Then cut the bread in thin slices, lengthwise of the loaf. Spread each slice with butter, cream cheese, cream cheese tinted with food coloring, or any sandwich filling. Firmly roll up each slice from the end like a jelly roll. If desired, place a row of the stuffed olives across this end before starting to roll. Wrap seam side down in waxed paper, then in a damp cloth, chill for at least 1/2 hr., and slice across in thin slices.

PINWHEEL POTHOLDER #5522

Materials Required—

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"DE LUXE" MERCERIZED AND KNITTING
COTTON, ARTICLE 346

1—250 yd. Ball White and

"STAR" PEARL COTTON, ARTICLE 90, SIZE 5

4—50 yd. Balls Blue will make the Round and Square Holders.
Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

With Blue, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c in ring, join.

2nd Row—2 s c in each s c, join.

3rd Row—Ch 1, * 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around, join.

4th Row—Ch 1 and work 1 s c in each s c, join, drop Blue. When changing Color always complete last half of st with next Color.

5th Row—Attach White, ch 3 (counts as 1/3 part of 1st puff st) and work 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in same space (puff st: thread over needle, insert in st, pull loop up the length of a d c, * thread over needle, insert in same space and pull loop up the same length, repeat from *, thread over and pull through all loops on needle but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops), * 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in next s c, repeat from * all around ending row with

1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, join in top of 1st puff st.

6th Row—Sl st into loop, drop White, pick up Blue, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each 2 ch loop and 1 s c in each st, join, drop Blue.

7th Row—With White work 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in the s c between puff sts, * 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in next s c, repeat from * all around, ending row with 1 s c in each of the next 4 sts, join in top of 1st puff st, sl st into loop, drop White.

8th Row—Same as 6th row.

9th Row—With White, work 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in the s c between the 2 puff sts and 1 s c in each s c in each s c section.

Repeat the 8th and 9th rows having 2 more s c in each s c section every other row until there are 10 Blue and 11 White stripes ending with the White row, break thread. Work another section in same manner.

With Blue, crochet the 2 sections together as follows: attach thread in loop between puff sts, ch 3, 4 d c in same space, ** ch 1, skip 1 st, s c in next st, * ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 d c in next st, ch 1, skip 1 st, s c in next st, repeat from * 4 times, ch 1, 5 d c in next loop between puff sts, repeat from ** all around.

With Blue, cover a bone ring with s c and attach to potholder.

SQUARE PINWHEEL POTHOLDER #5523

With Blue, ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 8 s c in ring, join.

2nd Row—2 s c in each s c, join each row.

3rd Row—* 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from * all around.

4th Row—1 s c in each s c, drop Blue. When changing Color always complete last half of st with next Color.

5th Row—Attach White, ch 3 (counts as 1/3 part of 1st puff st) and work 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in same space (puff

st: thread over needle, insert in st, pull up the length of a d c
* thread over needle, insert in same space, pull up the same length, repeat from *, thread over and pull through all loops on needle but one, thread over and pull through 2 loops), * 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in next s c, repeat from * twice ending row with 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, join in top of 1st puff st, sl st into loop, drop White.

6th Row—Pick up Blue, ch 1 and work * 3 s c in the ch 2 loop, 1 s c in next puff st, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 1 s c in next puff st, repeat from * all around joining in 1st s c.

7th Row—Sl st to next st, drop Blue, pick up White, ch 3 and work 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in same space, * 1 s c in each of the next 9 s c, 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in next s c, repeat from * twice, 1 s c in each of the next 9 sts, join in top of 1st puff st, sl st into loop, drop White.

8th Row—With Blue, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each s c on sides, 1 s c in each puff st at corners and 3 s c in each corner loop, join, sl st to next st, drop Blue.

9th Row—With White, work 1 s c in each s c and 2 puff sts with ch 2 between in center s c at each corner, join in top of 1st puff st, sl st into loop, drop White.

Repeat the 8th and 9th rows until there are 13 White and 12 Blue stripes. Work another section in same manner reversing the Colors. With White, crochet the 2 sections together as follows: attach thread in corner loop, ch 3, 4 d c in same space, *
